Literacy

In reading pupils will have the opportunity to engage with a variety of texts. We will be learning to ask and answer different types of questions to determine the purpose of a text.

We will continue to use phonics to spell words and we will also continue to focus literacy homework on common words.

Literacy and numeracy set tasks will be given out on a Monday and should be returned on a Thursday as and when appropriate.

We will continue to focus on developing story writing but will also learn to write letters and postcards. We will improve our editing skills and will begin to learn how to use joining words to connect sentences.

Health & Wellbeing

In P.E. we will be focussing on our fitness as we get ready for sports day. P2M will develop their love for nature through our outdoor learning sessions.

Numeracy and Maths

Pupils will continue to develop their understanding of number through SEAL numeracy. We will revise addition and subtraction strategies and explore the link between counting in groups and Times Tables. In maths we will be focussing on time. Pupils should continue to use their numeracy homework pack to develop learning at home. They will also receive a short piece of written homework as and when appropriate.

Learning in other areas of the curriculum

This term we will begin to find out more about our local area. Hopefully we will be able to go out a few afternoons to explore the environment in and around the school.

In art we will use nature from our outdoor learning sessions and garden time, as a stimulus to improve our drawing skills.

In R.M.E. we will be learning about places of worship and how people express their beliefs

- Please make sure reading bags are brought every day as we use our reading books for other activities on non-reading days too.
