This year has presented many challenges for the classes and they have coped remarkably well. They have made us very proud and we hope they enjoy their final week at primary school. Primary 7 children will be issued lateral flow testing kits from our school, with an instruction leaflet, to ensure they can begin testing before they start High School in August.

Free School Meals	Return to school	
Many of you will already be aware of the Scottish Government's commitment to offering free school meals to all primary age children. This will be a roll-out programme starting with Primary 4 children getting a free school meal in August 2021 as well as all children in P1-3, as was previously the case. Dates of when P5-7 will begin receiving their free school meal will be confirmed in due course. The lunch menus will continue to operate on a 3 week rota and families should have received these already. When we return in August there is a form for those children who will be in P2-4 to select their meals for Wednesday 18th, Thursday 19th and Friday 20th August. Our new Primary 1 children will receive a sandwich lunch on these days. Our lunch rotas will then begin on Week 2 on Monday 23rd August. If your children would prefer to bring their own lunch from home then please provide a packed lunch. Primary 5-7 pupils should continue to bring packed lunches until further notice.	At this point in time we are expecting schools to return in August with the same guidance in place as we have been following thus far. Should this guidance change before our return we will communicate with parents via Groupcall emails and our School App for Parents. Please check for updates nearer the return date on Wednesday 18th August. Our new Primary 1 classes will only be in from 9.30am - 12pm Wednesday 18th, Thursday 19th and Friday 20th August. All other classes will have staggered entry and exit times as from Wednesday 18th August, as shown in the table below. Adults will be in the playground before school to help children with these locations.
